Ga. 1979)(copyright infringement of the novel and film Gone With The Wind, (ii) Schmidt v. Quigg, 609 F. Supp. 227 (E.D. Mich. 1985), rev'g In re Schmidt, 222 U.S.P.Q. 643 (T.T.A.B. 1984) (registrability of the mark Honey Baked Ham) and (iii) Schmidt v. Honeysweet Hams, Inc., 656 F. Supp. 92 (N.D. Ga. 1986 (infringement of the Honey Baked Ham mark). Additionally, in Syntex (U.S.A.), Inc. v. Apotex, Inc. N.D. Ga. 1994), Mr. Lunsford was one of the first attorneys in the United States to successfully rely on the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act as the basis for obtaining a preliminary injunction precluding defendants from competing unfairly by making false representations in violation of the Act.

Mr. Lunsford has served as a member of the editorial board of the *Trademark Reporter* for the International Trademark Association. He is a past Chairman of the Intellectual Property Section of the State Bar of Georgia and a past president of
